

Rules & Regulations

- All horses must have a negative Coggins, ideally sent electronically in advance of the show with the entries.
- Please keep all dogs on a leash at all times.
- Schooling is permitted in the show ring on Saturday by appointment, or on show day between 8am and 9:30am. Hand walking horses to see the arena and jumps will be permitted during course walks.
- No lunging allowed in show or warm up arenas. Lunging in parking field is permitted - there's plenty of room!
- Courses will be posted at 9:30am, after the arena is closed for schooling.
- All judging and appointments to follow USEF rules.
- Formal attire is encouraged. Show attire is required.
- Each horse and rider combination is eligible for entering one hunter derby only. Horses may be entered in multiple derbies with different riders, and vice versa.
- Management reserves the right to cancel, combine, split, or reschedule classes as needed.
- Please do not enter barns, wash racks, or pastures without permission from The Farm at One Under Lane staff.
- Riders must be present to receive overall awards. If rider has left prior to the presentation of overall awards, the judge will select a different rider.

Class Descriptions

Walk/Trot - open to riders who have not shown at the canter. No cross-entry. The Poles Classic will be a course of poles to be shown at the trot.

Pleasure Horse/Pony - open to all. To be judged on suitability, manners, way of going, and style. Hunter Hack class to consist of showing both directions at all gaits followed by a single line of crossrails. May be asked to halt, back up, or lengthen the trot.

Crossrails - open to riders who have not competed above 18". No cross-entry into higher classes. Equitation will be a single round. Hunter Derby will be a two round format.

Limit - open to horses and/or riders who have not competed above 2'3". Two round format. Class may be split into a green horse division if entries warrant.

Black Tie Affair Memorial Equitation Challenge - open to all junior and amateur riders. Two round class, with everyone completing a medal-style course and no less than the top 6 riders returning for a flat phase.

T.I.P. Handy Hunter Classic - open to all eligible Thoroughbreds. Single round class. Card open with the heights, beginning during class 7. Will be pinned and presented after class 12.

Jump for a JustWorld Handy Hunter Challenge - open to all. Single round class, to be offered at 2', 2'6", 2'9", and 3'. Card open beginning during class 7. Will be pinned and presented after class 12.

Open Hunter Derby - open to all. Two round format.

Intro Jumper - open to all. May not cross-enter into classes above 2'6".

Open Jumper - open to all.

T.I.P. Jumper Classic - open to all eligible Thoroughbreds. Table II.2b


Mini Prix - open to all. Table II.2a format.

USHJA Outreach Rewards and Awards

Earn points towards year-end rewards and awards with a free USHJA Outreach Membership!

USHJA Outreach Competitions and Classes provide opportunity to earn national recognition in classes from walk/trot to 3'0" in hunter, equitation, and .60m-1.20m in jumper sections at rated and unrated local shows.

Rewards

Riders and owners of USHJA Outreach registered horses can earn level status and points to redeem at the end of the year for items such as USHJA logo wear, Outreach ribbons or Outreach medallions.

Bronze Level: Riders or horses must earn at least 50-74 points during the competition year

Silver Level: Riders or horses must earn at least 75-99 points during the competition year

Gold Level: Riders or horses must earn at least 100 points during the competition year

Awards

New! Exciting year-end awards will be given to trainers, riders and horses.

Trainers—Earn the USHJA Outreach High Point Trainer Award by being the leading trainer in your zone whose riders have earned 100 or more points cumulatively in USHJA Outreach Classes.

Riders— In addition to awards and rewards, one high point rider from each Zone will earn a Golden Backstage Pass to participate in the USHJA National Championship Affiliate sections and get exclusive access to free educational sessions and National Championship Grand Prix and Hunter Derby course walks!

Horses—While horse recording and microchipping is not required to participate in Outreach classes, owners wishing for their horses to earn points must have them recorded with USHJA (\$20/annual or \$75/lifetime). Horses will have their Outreach points tracked and ranked within their USHJA Zone and displayed on ushja.org.
